**Children’s RE Policies – please read and indicate Yes or NO on line provided.**

- **Behavior Guidelines (required):** If a child becomes disrespectful and/or out of covenant he/she will be removed from the classroom by the DRE. If the behavior continues a parent will be called. Examples include: Inappropriate comments, unkindness, and uncooperative with the group guidelines.
- **Parent/Guardian Present (Required):** A parent or guardian must be present on church grounds during RE class time. This is NOT a drop and pick up program.
- **Sick Child (Required):** If your child is ill, please do not bring them to church.

**Volunteer Opportunities for Cooperative Program**

- Cleaning parties 2x year (cleaning classrooms, repairing, moving furniture).
- Assist with holiday parties, RE plays/services.
- Story for all ages in sanctuary at service time (see DRE for guidelines)
- Share talent/skills in RE. Coordinate with DRE. Skills I can share:

**Permissions – Please read and initial**

- **Medical Treatment (Require):** I authorize the RE supervisor to take responsibility for securing first aid or medical aid if either is required.
  - **Transportation (Required):** Transportation must be worked out among parents. The UUFSLOC is not responsible for transportation.
  - **Walk around the neighborhood:** RE teachers supervise walk to Meadow park, around neighborhood, Youth to donut/bagel shop. Initial required to participate
  - **Pictures Internal:** Pictures may be posted to UU bulletin boards.
  - **Pictures External:** Pictures of me or my child(ren) may be posted on UU website, News and Notes, or in a closed group Facebook page.
  - **I understand RE ends at 12:15, p/u in RE area. Children are not to run through the social hall, the church, our around the building for the safety of all. Once the children are picked up they are no longer under RE supervision.(Required)**
  - **All parents/guardians are expected to assist in RE. Ask DRE if you’re unsure.**
